


Feel like a chef!!



Childrens' apron



Materials	
Patterned fabric A	50 cm x 50 cm
Patterned fabric B	15 cm x 25 cm
Lace	1.5 m
Bias tape	2.8 m

Finished size: Width: 48 cm
Length: 50 cm

★ This project is sized to fit a child 100 cm tall.
Adjust the length of the apron and its strings according to the height of the child.

Cutting guide


* Cut out the main piece as shown below, and cut out the pocket according to the pattern.

* The basic seam allowance is 1.0 cm.




* ——— Cutting line

* Arrows indicate the direction of the fabric grain.




Pocket

*Step 1


Finish the sides.

- ① Turn the edges of the sides to the inside twice, and then stitch them.

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

0.5 cm
Turn a 1 cm seam allowance to the inside twice, and then stitch it. (Do this on the left and on the right.)

*Step 2

Finish the top edge and hem.

- ① Cover the top edge with bias tape, and then finish the seam allowance. Decorate by sewing on lace.

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

- ② Cover the hem with bias tape, and then finish the seam allowance. Fold the hem as shown in Fig.a to create a clean finish. Decorate by sewing on lace.

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

★ Decorate as desired, using lace, braiding, etc.





Turn in 1 cm to align with the edge of the hem, and then fold over the hem.

*Step 3

Attach the strings.

- ① Finish the back ties, armholes and neck tie with 1 piece of bias tape. Leaving an extra 45 cm of tape, cover one armhole, leave 65 cm for the neck tie, and then cover the other armhole. Fold the end of the tape as shown in Fig.a, and then cleanly finish it. Be careful that the bias tape is not stretched while it is sewn.

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

★ Adjust the length of the apron and its strings according to the height of the child.




*Step 4

Attach the pocket.

① Make the pocket.

Turn the opening of the pocket to the inside twice, and then stitch it

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

② Turn back a 1 cm seam allowance on the other sides of the pocket (finish the edges of the seam allowances with overlock or zigzag stitching), and then decorate by sewing on lace.

Note

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.

★ Decorate as desired, using lace, braiding, etc.

③ Position on the apron as shown, and then stitch it.

Sew reverse stitches at the beginning and end of stitching.





