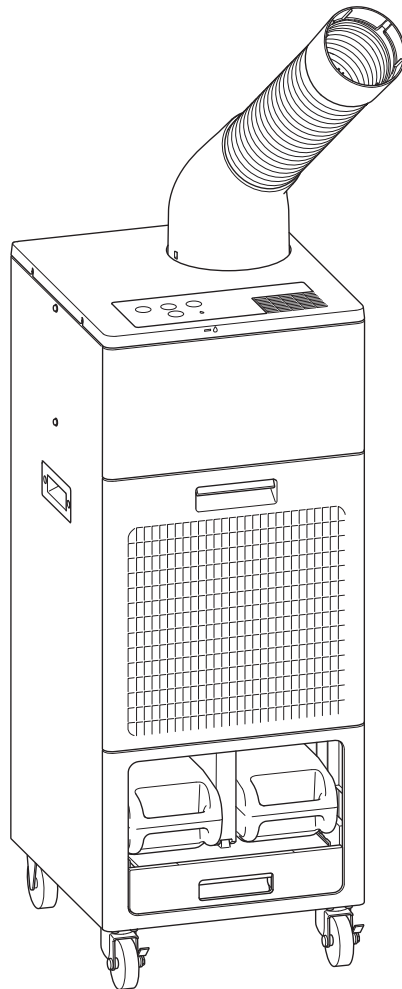

Use the Product Safely

Wiring power supplies and devices





	If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
	Always connect the earth before use. Also, use an electrical socket equipped with an earth leakage breaker. Incomplete earthing may result in an electric shock.
  	Use the AC 220 to 240 V power supply. DO NOT use with a DC power supply or inverter (DC-AC conversion device). This may cause a fire or electric shock. If you are not sure whether the electrical socket for connecting this product is an AC or DC power supply, consult a qualified electrician.
	Make sure you insert the power plug firmly into the electrical socket. If the plug is not inserted securely, water, dust, or other foreign matter may get into the gap, causing a fire or electric shock.
	Periodically unplug the power cord and power plug from the electrical socket and check them for damage, such as heat generation, rust, bends, abrasions, or cracks. Continuing to use a damaged cord may cause a fire or electric shock.
 	DO NOT forcibly bend, pull, or alter the power cord, or use the power cord while it is bundled. Damage to the power cord may cause a fire.
	Do not move this product by dragging it by the power cord or run over the power cord with casters. Damage to the power cord may cause a fire.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT use the unit with the casters (with lock) unlocked. The unit may move unintentionally, posing a risk of injury to the operator. In particular, lock the casters when operating the panel, installing or removing the duct, removing the tank, and during maintenance. • DO NOT remove or damage any of the caution or warning labels inside the product.

Other precautions (continued)

IMPORTANT

	Use the unit in an area with sufficient ventilation. Using the unit in a small enclosed space increases the humidity, which not only prevents the unit from achieving its cooling capacity, but may also trigger rusting on nearby metal equipment due to moisture.
	Leave a sufficient space (50 cm or more) around the unit's air intake. Placing the air intake too close to a wall or other obstacle may result in insufficient airflow and reduced performance.
	Keep the unit horizontal. Installing the unit at an angle may cause water to leak.
	Use tap water. Using well water or industrial water may cause odours to develop.
	Always drain the remaining water every day at the end of operation. Leaving water in the water tank or sub-tank may cause odours due to a decay or microbial growth.
	When transporting or moving the unit, be sure to secure the water tank, cooling air duct, and other parts securely before moving it.
	Depending on the type of dust or mist in the environment, the product may be damaged, leading to malfunctions or reduced performance.
	When transporting or moving this product, run the drying operation and then drain the water from the water tank and sub tank before moving it. Submitting the unit to vibrations or tilting the unit may cause water to leak.
	DO NOT move the unit while it is operating. This may cause a water leakage or malfunctions.
	Do not subject the unit to sudden changes in the temperature environment. Sudden changes in temperature may cause condensation to form inside the unit, which may cause damage.
	The cooling from the spot and exhaust ports is humid, so DO NOT place objects that are susceptible to rust in front of the unit.
	DO NOT use the unit in an environment where oil particles are suspended in the air. The circulating water may become contaminated with oil and become unusable. Install the unit in a location where clean outside air can enter.
	DO NOT put any objects on top of the product. Doing so may cause the product to malfunction.
	DO NOT remove the label with the serial number attached to the unit.
DO NOT rotate the swinging part using excessive force.
